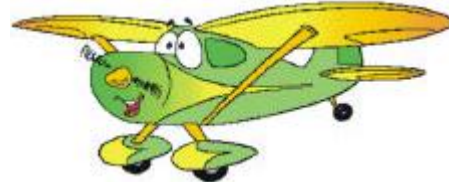


Several of the members have been flying and having a good time on the days the weather permits. Come on out and join us!
